Purpose

The Parish Lengthsman is a locally employed person who can really make a difference to the community by maintaining roadside verges and drainage, siding out footways, gully clearance, litter picking, vegetation clearance, strimming along public footpaths and carrying out local repairs (e.g. parish benches) as and when required or identified.

Applicants

- The successful applicant will be self-employed, hold public liability insurance and have a good local knowledge of Cabus
- Will be expected to provide verbal/written activity reports at Cabus Parish Council meetings (6 times per year).
- All tools, transport and protective clothing will be supplied by the successful applicant.
- The contract for services is based on 175 hrs per annum (approx. 5 hours per week, 35 weeks of the year - primarily the growing season), for which the work can be carried out at any time during the month.
- The rate will be £12.00 - £14.00 per hour paid upon receipt of monthly invoices.
- A copy of your current Public Liability insurance will be required on application.
